**Sir:**

On November 13, 1990, the Laboratory received the following for examination and tests:

- Exhibit #12 One brown paper bag labeled "Green Blanket" and containing one olive green blanket
- Exhibit #13 One brown paper bag labeled "Green Blanket" and containing one olive green blanket
- Exhibit #14 One brown paper bag labeled "Green Blanket" and containing one olive green blanket
- Exhibit #15 One brown paper bag labeled "Green Blanket" and containing one olive green blanket
- Exhibit #16 One brown paper bag labeled "Paper Towel" and containing one white paper towel
- Exhibit #17 One brown paper bag labeled "Blue Panties" and containing one pair of blue and black panties

Serological analysis of the blanket (Exhibit #12) revealed the presence of seminal fluid. Further analysis can be performed upon submission of the suspect's blood and saliva standards.

Serological analysis of Exhibit #13 (blanket), Exhibit #14 (blanket), Exhibit #15 (blanket), Exhibit #16 (paper towel) and Exhibit #17 (panties) failed to indicate the presence of seminal fluid.

Laboratory examination of Exhibit #12 (blanket) revealed the presence of three Caucasian head hairs suitable for comparison.


Laboratory examination of Exhibit #13 (blanket) revealed the presence of five Caucasian head hairs suitable for comparison.

Laboratory examination of Exhibit #17 (panties) revealed the presence of one Caucasian pubic hair and two Caucasian head hairs suitable for comparison.

Further analysis of Exhibits #12, #13 and #17 can be performed upon resubmission of the victim's head hair standard and pubic hair standard and the suspect's head hair standard and pubic hair standard.


The evidence is available for pickup.
