AFFIDAVIT FOR SEARCH  
WARRANT

STATE OF OHIO  
COUNTY OF PREBLE, SS:

The undersigned affiant, having been first duly cautioned and sworn according to law, deposes and states that he has reason to believe that there is now contained in the body of Guy Billy Lee Scott, certain property, to-wit: head hair and pubic hair of the defendant, Guy Billy Lee Scott, which constitutes potential evidence of a crime allegedly committed by the defendant, Guy Billy Lee Scott, this in violation of Ohio Revised Code Section 2903.02, entitled "Murder" and in violation of Ohio Revised Code Section 2907.02, entitled "Rape".

Said property is now being concealed and/or contained on the body of the defendant who is presently incarcerated in the Preble County Jail.

The facts tending to establish the grounds for the issuance of a Search Warrant are that on July 8, 1990, in New Paris, Ohio, at approximately 11:30 p.m., the defendant and the victim, Lesa Buckley, were seen leaving a party together; that this party was on the premises of American Aggregates at Cedar Lake, Preble County, Ohio; that on July 9, 1990, in New Paris, Ohio, at approximately 12:15 a.m., the defendant was observed returning to the party alone; that the defendant and his clothing were observed to be soaking wet; that the victim's body was later discovered in Cedar Lake; that the defendant was the person who reported finding the body; that in the course of the investigation, the undersigned recovered several blankets containing human hairs suitable for comparison; that said human hairs are of a color and type that are consistent with those of

the defendant; that samples of the victim's hair are also available for comparison; that the defendant has been reported as saying or making references which indicate that he killed the victim.

The affiant further states that a Search Warrant is required to obtain and remove head hairs of the defendant (at least 25 head hairs and 20 pubic hairs), sufficient for laboratory analysis, identification and matching with known samples of similar evidence collected during the investigation of the above described incident. That said samples are necessary for the prompt and efficient investigation of said incident and may in fact tend to exculpate the defendant as well as implicate him in this incident.
