Dear Nancy:

I am representing Alicia K. Heath in her divorce from Gary S. Heath. That final divorce hearing is scheduled for Thursday, September 5, 1991. We expect no child support to be ordered since Mr. Heath is currently incarcerated at Dayton Human Rehabilitation Center.

I am writing this letter to request that Mrs. Heath not be required to cooperate in the collection of child support from Mr. Heath. Recently Mr. Heath plead "guilty" to the crime of "Assault", in violation of Ohio Revised Code Section 2903.13(A). State of Ohio v. Gary Heath, Case No. 91-CR-6841 (C.P. Preble County. August 2, 1991). The victim was Mrs. Heath, who was stabbed in the neck very near the carotid artery. While in jail awaiting trial, Mr. Heath wrote several threatening letters to Mrs. Heath. That resulted in additional criminal charges being filed against him. He later plead "guilty" to the crime of "Aggravated Menacing", in violation of Ohio Revised Code Section 2903.21(A). State of Ohio v. Gary Heath, Case No. 91-CR-6887 (C.P. Preble County. August 2, 1991). His current incarceration is the result of these two convictions.

Also while awaiting trial, Mr. Heath made a statement to David Lindloff, investigator for the Preble County Prosecutor's Office. In that statement Mr. Heath described his activities as a cocaine dealer and his participation in the cover-up of a murder, including the dumping of the body. He then told Mr. Lindloff about looking up one of the alleged murderers shortly after the attack on Mrs. Heath. His stated purpose was to convince this person to harm his wife (See Case No. 91-CR-6841.)
